1. Ask customers to donate.
2. If they say “Yes, I’ll donate \$5.00,” girls should collect the money on the spot, and keep track of it. (Encourage customers to donate whatever they are able.) Checks should be made out to “Girl Scouts of Nassau County.”
3. Tally “Operation Stop Hunger” donations. Deposit the money, minus the Troop rebate,** in the GSNC Fall Products Account, along with your regular deposit.
4. Credit girls with the donation by entering it in the Ashdon Farms Nut-e system. There is a column for it. Donations count towards girl’s incentive prizes and Troop rebate.
5. You will never have to handle these items. They will be shipped directly from the [Mags&Munchies](#) (Fall Products Program) Cupboard.
6. You may continue to accept donations for “Operation Stop Hunger” until the sale ends.
