Lottery - All registrations received on or before February 8, 2010 are eligible for placement by lottery. After February 8, 2010 applications will be processed in the order received. Plan to register early as some sessions fill very quickly.

Sibling Discount - Receive a \$10 per session discount for each additional daughter attending camp.

Bring a Friend Rebate - Returning campers register a friend for Girl Scout camp who has never attended before and receive a \$25 rebate check. Rebate checks will be issued at the end of the summer.
