



Trip Chaperone Agreement

I understand that as an adult chaperone I play an essential role in the success of the trip and that my attitudes, behavior, and responsibilities as a role model are critical to the quality of the experience.

Therefore, I agree to do the following:

- Be sensitive to the needs of each girl participant
- Respect the places and the people with whom I come in contact
- Understand that I will be responsible for girls other than my daughter
- Ensure that [Girl Scout Safety Checkpoints](#) and [GSNC Policies Standards and Guidelines](#) are followed
- Be responsible for the safety and well being of ALL participants during this trip
- Participate in trip evaluation
- Be responsible for my personal belongings

I also understand that:

- Girl Scouts of Nassau County's policy on the use of drugs and alcohol *"Alcoholic beverages (including beer and wine), marijuana, narcotics (except by doctor's prescription), or illegal drugs of any kind must not be brought, sold, bought or used at any Council, Association, Camp or Troop girl event."* MUST be followed at all times during the trip
- As a chaperone, I will not go anywhere that children are not allowed (i.e., bars, lounges, etc.)
- I will not smoke in the vicinity of any girls on the trip

Remember: While on this trip, you are responsible for both the behavior and the needs of the girls entrusted to your care. Please pay close attention to both. Wherever we are, we represent Girl Scouts of Nassau County.
