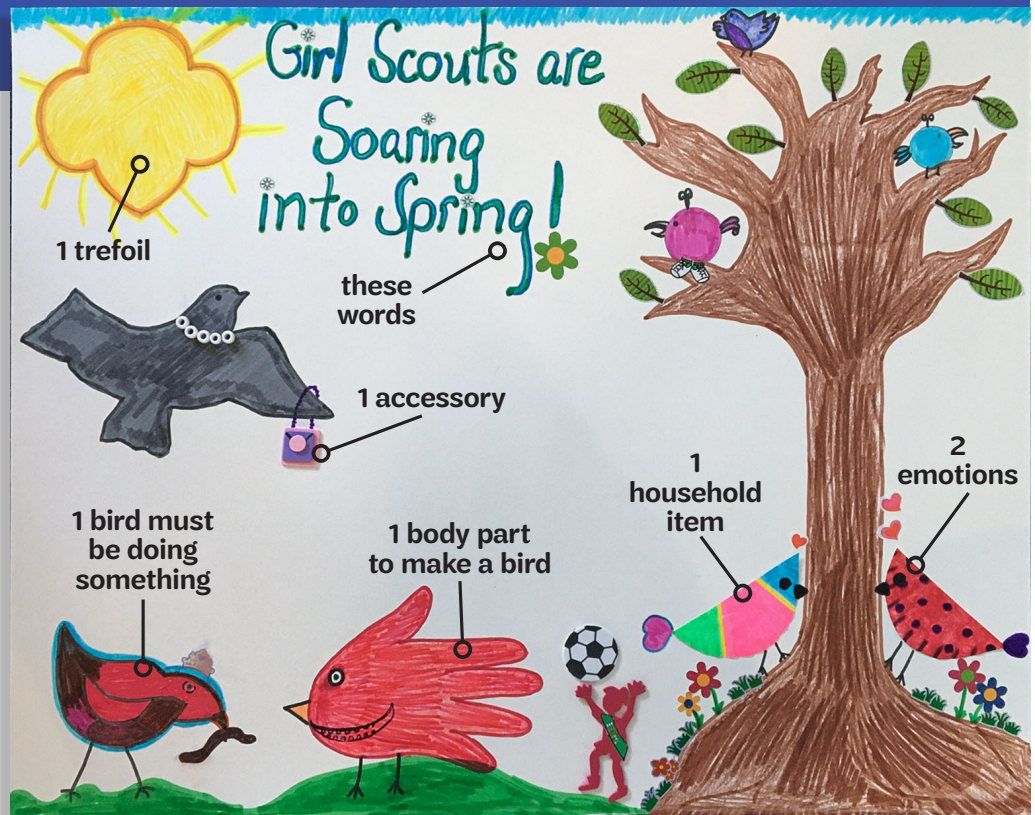


Girl Scouts are Soaring into Spring Poster Contest

Who can make a poster? Everyone can join in the fun, but only registered Girl Scouts and registered leaders can enter the contest.

When is the deadline to submit posters? April 15, 2020

How many winners? Six Girl Scouts will be selected in total, one from each Girl Scout level and three Girl Scout leaders.

Who are the judges? Our CEO and her Girl Squad

When will the winners be announced? April 21, 2020

What kind of prizes? Winners will receive a patch, a gift certificate to the GSNC Shop, and they will appear in one of our publications.

Poster Contest Rules:

Drawings may be any size, recycled materials are strongly encouraged.

Poster must include:

- One trefoil
- The words "Girl Scouts are Soaring into Spring"
- A minimum of two birds
- A bird made with a household item
- At least one bird must be featured doing something
- At least one bird must have an accessory

- A tracing of one of your own body parts to make a bird
- Two emotions displayed
- Your poster's story written on the back in one or two sentences

How to Submit your poster:

- Email photos of your poster front and back to marketing@gsnc.org by April 15.
- Your email subject must read "GS Soaring into Spring 2020 Poster Contest."
- You must include your first and last name, troop number or indicate that you are a Juliette on the back of the poster.
- Posters must be submitted by a parent or guardian with the understanding that the poster will be publicly displayed.
