Why should my Girl Scout participate in the Girl Scout Cookie Program?

The Girl Scout Cookie Program fuels your Girl Scout's adventures throughout the year: exploring what interests them, discovering their passions, and taking action on issues they care about. Whether they're using STEM skills to solve a problem, changing a law to help their community, having a courageous outdoor experience, or starting an innovative nonprofit, a Girl Scout builds a better future for themselves and the world. Through the Girl Scout Cookie Program, not only do Girl Scouts become entrepreneurs as they gain hands-on experience running their own small business, they also develop concrete skills (Goal Setting, Decision Making, Money Management, People Skills, and Business Ethics) that last a lifetime. Yet, even with all of that great learning and earning, year after year Girl Scouts tell us the number one reason they participate in the Girl Scout Cookie Program is because it's FUN!

Did you know? All proceeds from Girl Scout Cookie program stays local! When your friends and family purchase Girl Scout Cookies from your young, bright entrepreneur, they're supporting their success today and tomorrow.

Girl Scout Cookie proceeds...

- 1. Cover the costs of running the Girl Scout Cookie Program, including the costs of cookies, materials, and logistics.
- 2. Fund Take Action projects for the community and amazing Girl Scout-led adventures for troops.
- 3. Help our council provide financial assistance so all Girl Scouts can have amazing experiences in STEM programs, the outdoors, life skills, and entrepreneurship, as well as camp, leadership training, and more.

Ways to sell

There are many ways to sell Girl Scout Cookies, and each one helps Girl Scouts gain different skills along the way. Let your Girl Scout take the lead in picking how they want to run their business.

Order cards: Girl Scouts can use the card to track customers and their orders. Contact friends and family over the phone or bring the order card to an in-person family activity.

Direct sales: This happens after your Girl Scout has cookies in hand; no need to keep customers waiting! Girl Scouts can go door-to-door, pull a wagon through their neighborhood, and more (all with help from a caregiver).

Cookie booths (in-person and virtual): Cookie pop-up sales in areas with lots of foot traffic are a fun way for your Girl Scout to connect with their community and practice their sales pitch with new customers. Booth locations must be approved by your troop cookie manager and our council and take place within our council jurisdiction. Participants must follow all council guidelines about setting up, running, and taking down a booth. Your Girl Scout can also host virtual cookie booths to promote their cookie business, where they make their pitch via video and direct customers to their Digital Cookie® site. Look for communication from GSNC and your troop regarding booth sale regulations that may change after this booklet is printed due to any updated council guidance in place when booth sales are taking place.

Online sales: Use Digital Cookie to reach customers near and far. Your Girl Scout can promote their site by emailing friends and family and creating videos to share on social media where they make their pitch online. There are endless ways for your Girl Scout to get creative in spreading the word about their Digital Cookie site. And the best part for you? All of the cookies are paid for online so no money to collect or hand in!

Watch your email in January for an invitation for your Girl Scout to set up their Digital Cookie site. If you don't receive the invitation by January 3, click on the email request prompt at: digitalcookie.girlscouts.org

Donation program: Customers who are looking for ways to support your Girl Scout, but don't want to purchase cookies for themselves, can donate packages of cookies to GSNC's Gift of Caring program. With the generous support of DHL Express, cookies will be donated to the U.S. military locally and throughout the world through our Operation Cookie program and we will be continuing to donate cookies through the Hometown Heroes program. Customers can support Gift of Caring through any of the above selling methods. Donations also count toward Girl Scout rewards and troop proceeds.

WAYS TO SUPPORT YOUR COOKIE-PRENEUR:

- Help them earn the Cookie Entrepreneur Family pin to practice building their skills at home.
- Help them set up their Digital Cookie site.
- Help them keep money safe.
- Know the rules and safety guidelines.
- Model business ethics, decision making, people skills, and safety as you support them.
- Review the order card together so that they know their product. While looking at the rewards opportunities, encourage them to set a goal.
- Ask their troop leader how you can help the whole troop reach its goals. Your Girl Scout will learn to be a helper and take action by watching you.
- Help them make arrangements to connect with people in their network.
- Never do things for your Girl Scout that they can do for themselves, even if it's quicker and easier for you to do them.
- Have fun together along the way and engage your whole family in supporting them.
