



Bridging to Cadettes

This is what the average troop does as far as who pays for what. You can choose to do as you wish. Since you are bridging soon, I highly suggest you encourage your parent to renew for next Girl Scout year before you have your bridging.

UNIFORMS: Parents pay for (Troop usually votes for sash or vest)

- Traditional Vest** \$30.00
- New Cargo Style Vest** \$40.00
- Sash** \$12.50
- Sash w/pocket** \$17.50
- Insignia tab** \$4.75
- Flag** \$2.75
- Council ID** \$7.50
- Numerals** \$2.00 each
- Crest** \$2.75 (if you have one)
- Wings** \$2.25

TROOP PAYS FOR:

- Star** \$2.00
- Bridge to Cadette:** \$3.25
- Cadette Disc:** \$2.75 (package of 24)

OPTIONAL but highly suggested for each girl:

- Handbook** \$9.00
- Badge Magic** \$8.50
Makes putting badges/patches on much easier
- Heat Press:** \$10.00 for setup patches listed.
- Backpack** \$5.00
(Many leaders gave them as bridging gifts to the girls. It's great for the girls to keep all their Girl Scout items together in one place.)

The only items that move from the Junior vest to the Cadette vest are the following:

- All stars and discs**
- All summit awards**
- World Pin**
- Girl Scout Pin**
- Bronze Award Pin**
- 5 Year Pin**
- 110th Anniversary Pin GSUSA**
- 100th Anniversary Pin GSNC**
- 100th Anniversary Cookie Pin**

VEST SIZING: These are in ADULT sizing, so sizing is different than the Junior vest. This vest is also worn from 3 to 7 years. Most troops will have one vest for Cadettes (3 years) then purchase a new vest for Senior/Ambassador (4 years), but the same vest can be worn for all 7 years if you choose. Available sizes are different for the cargo and traditional vest

Cargo: S/M/L/XL/2X/3X/4X

This vest is more fitted and made with a different material

Traditional: S/M/L/XL/1X/2X/3X
