



Bridging to Seniors

Below are some common troop practices for covering the cost of Girl Scout items. While every troop is different and you can decide what works best for your group, we encourage leaders to remind families to renew their Girl Scout membership for the upcoming year before the troop's bridging ceremony.

UNIFORMS: Paid for by parents (*troop usually votes for sash or vest*)

- **Traditional Vest** \$30
- **Sash w/pocket** \$17.50
- **Flag** \$2.75
- **Council ID** \$7.50
- **Numerals** \$2 each
- **Crest** \$2.75 (*if you have one*)
- **Wings** \$2.25

TROOP PAYS FOR:

- **Star** \$2
- **Bridge to Senior:** \$3.25
- **Cadette Disc:** \$2.75 (package of 24)

OPTIONAL but highly suggested for each girl:

Badge Magic \$8.50 (*Makes applying badges/patches much easier*)

Heat Press \$10 for setup of listed patches

Backpack \$7 (*Many leaders choose backpacks as bridging gifts. They're a great way for girls to keep all their Girl Scout essentials together.*)

The only items that move from the Cadette uniform to the Senior uniform are:

- **All stars and discs**
- **All summit awards**
- **World Pin**
- **Girl Scout Pin**
- **Insignia tab**
- **Bronze Award Pin**
- **Silver Award Pin**
- **5-Year Pin**
- **All GSNC/GSUSA Anniversary Pins**

** Bridges, cookie pins, safety award, and My Promise, My Faith awards do not move from Cadette uniform*

VEST SIZING: Available in ADULT sizes—different than the Cadette vest. This vest is worn for two years.

Sizes available: S/M/L/XL/1X/2X/3X

Sash available in regular and extra-long lengths.
